

Richie Elborne British Uniform Buckles

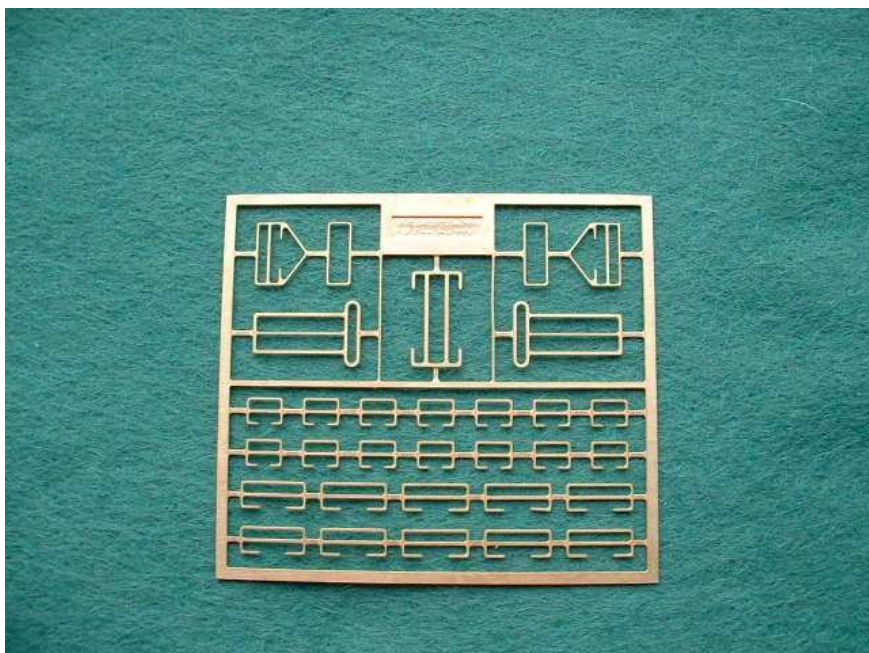
I am pleased to announce that following the preview at the York Figure show in March this year I have had the following sets of etched brass British Buckles produced. They have been chemicaly etched from 0.55mm thick brass sheet and are designed as accurate scale items although they can be used as replacements for the buckles on the BBi '37 pattern equipment sets and the older offerings from DML.

I plan to expand the range to encompass other buckle types not currently available and also to source and stock a variety of cotton tapes, available by the metre/yard that will help the scratchbuilder achieve scale accurate web equipment.

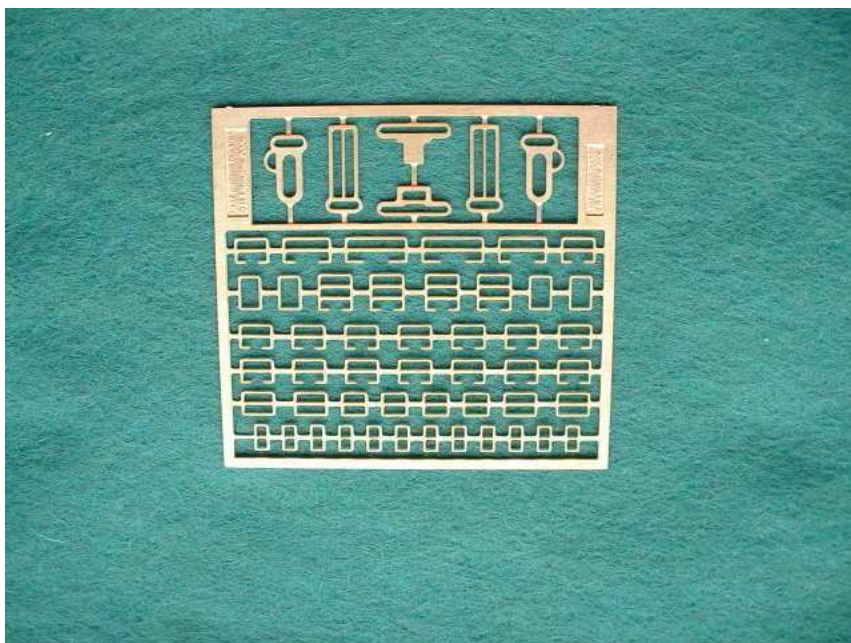
Each of the full buckle sets are designed to provide sufficient numbers and types to create one complete set of webbing with additional parts for brace attachments, bergan rucksacks etc etc.

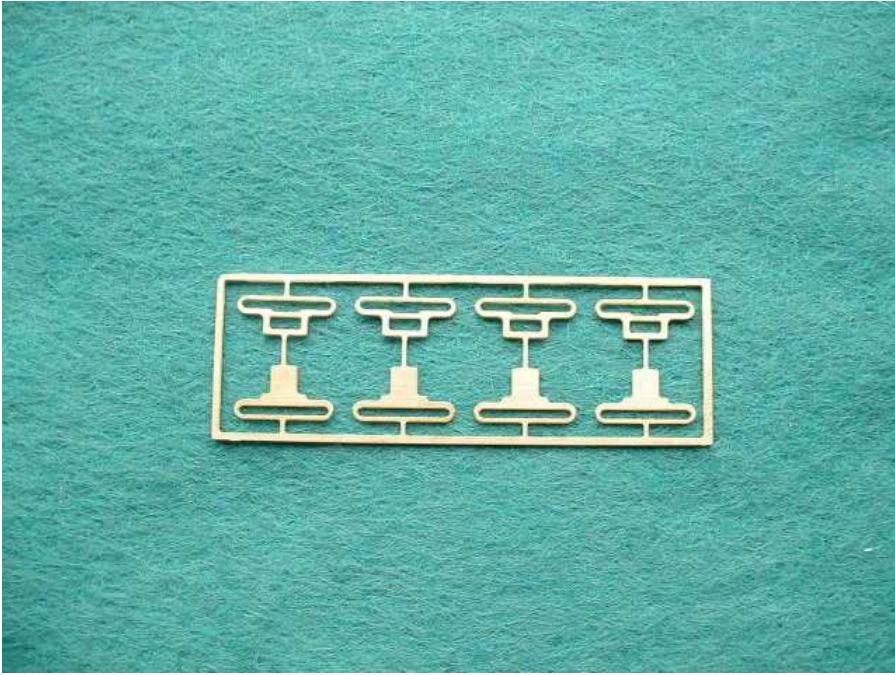
1908 pattern £6.50 inc p&p (UK)



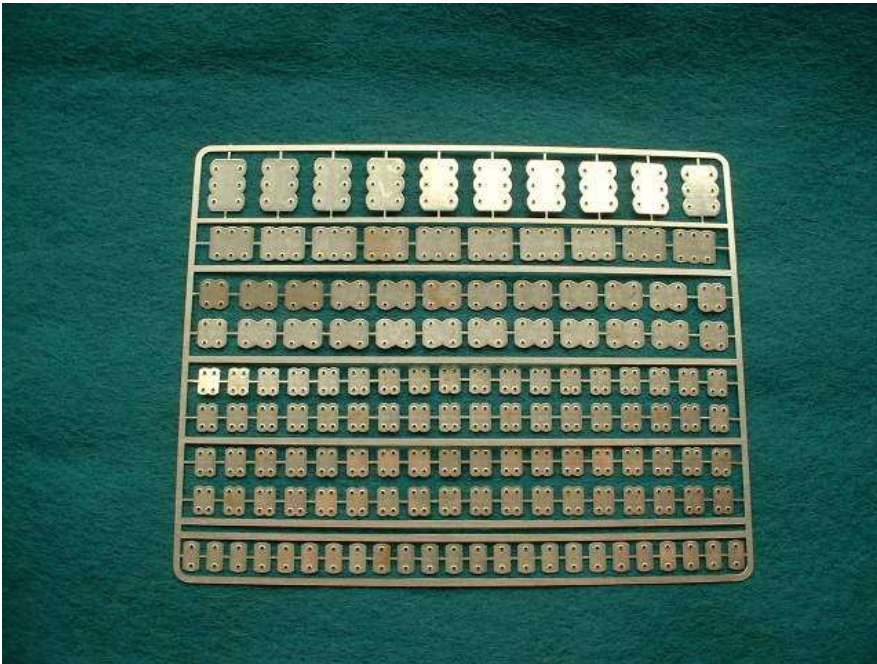
1937 pattern £6.50 inc p&p (UK)
